Strong together against Corona

Tests for the COVID-19 virus are necessary to detect and fight infections. But also to open up society step by step. Testing will quickly tell you where you stand. At the "Coronasneltest Duin- en Bollenstreek" in Noordwijkerhout we perform rapid tests from the manufacturer Roche and PCR tests. These validated tests have been approved by the government. If you take a quick test, you will know within 30 minutes if there is an infection with the COVID-19 virus.

Questions:

- **What is the difference between a quick test and a PCR test?**

PCR is the abbreviation for polymerase chain reaction. A COVID-19 PCR test is used to see if there is genetic material (RNA) of the COVID-19 virus in the nose or throat. With a cotton swab, a smear of the nose and throat is taken. The sample is then tested for DNA in the laboratory (approved by the RIVM). The process of analysis takes more time. The PCR is considered the gold standard and is therefore very suitable for travel, especially outside Europe, but also for the detection of COVID-19 contamination.

In many cases, this test is a prerequisite for being allowed to fly abroad.

The quick test is an antigen test in which the result is known much faster, hence the name "quick test". A nasal smear detects the virus protein of the virus on the back of the nasal cavity. The sample is used directly on a test cassette and displays the results within 15 minutes. Looks like a pregnancy test. The rapid test is very suitable for detecting the COVID-19 virus, but can also be used for travel with in most EU countries. You will then need to request a quick test in combination with a travel document via our website!

If you are travelling by car from the Netherlands to our Neighbouring countries, a quick test with a travel document (purchase within 24 hours) is often enough! For your own safety, always check the website of the respective country of destination!

- **How do I register for a quick test or a PCR test?**

For a quick test, a quick test with a travel document and a PCR test, you can make an appointment directly online at our location in Noordwijkerhout by www.coronasneltestduinenbollenstreek.nl To do this, keep your Citizen Service Number (BSN) (or if you come from abroad, the foreign residential number) at hand. You will find this number on your passport, identity card or driver's license. After your appointment is final, you will receive a confirmation of the appointment by e-mail.

- **What are the opening hours?**

At our location in Noordwijkerhout you can come every working day from 8 a.m. to 13 p.m. and on Saturday morning from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. for a quick test. A PCR test can be performed every working day from 9 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. Via our website you can make an appointment 24/7.

- **If I get tested positive, will I be reported to the GGD?**

Please note that we are obliged to report to the GGD. In the event of a positive result, we will pass on your data to THE GGD. For more information:
